




DISCOVER ÄNGELHOLM ... ON FOOT



A guide with three walking tours

This guide presents three hikes to do on your own in Ängelholm.

Ängelholm is located in north-western Skåne and the population is over 40 000 citizens. 6 km golden sandy beach lining the cove just outside the center.

Ängelholm is known including, clay cuckoos, Engelholm Glass, singers Jill Johnson and Jenny Silver, hockey players Kenny and Jörgen Jönsson and Gösta Carlsson, who has told us about his meeting with aliens which contributed to the UFO-monument.

Hiking 1 – Riverwalk 5,5 km

The walk takes you along the central parts of the Rönne river, which winds through the city. You pass several distinctive bridges. The ground is essentially gravel path. Stairs present.

Hiking 2 – Kronoskogenwalk 10,2 km


A nature walk in Kronoskogen close to both sea, sand and the extraterrestrial presence. The ground is everything from flat tarmac and gravel road to the small forest paths, partly marked trail.

Hiking 3 – Skäldervikenwalk 8,9 km

This hike takes you along Rönne river through Haradal and Luntertun to Skälderviken port. Varying surfaces, tarmac and gravel road into smaller paths.



HIKING 1 - RIVERWALK



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The walk takes you along the central parts of the Rönne river, which winds through the city. You pass several distinctive bridges. The ground is essentially gravel path. Stairs present.

Start/Finish: Main square at, Espresso House

Distance: 5,5 km

Route description:

The walk starts in the main square. Follow Storgatan 200 meter south until you reach a T-junction, turn left and follow the road. You pass a small park on your right side, "Vita Räck" and soon you reach a crossroads where you pass Karl XV bridge.

Immediately after the bridge, turn right down a stone staircase and follow the gravel road along the river.

Ängelholms hospital and new bath house, you can see to the left along the way.

After about 600 meter you reach Järnvägsgatan, which you cross. Continue the pedestrian and bike path which runs along the river. The sign "Kattegattleden" show you the way.

Kattegattleden is a 39 mil long bike path that runs along the west coast of Sweden, from Helsingborg in the south to Göteborg in the north.



Soon pass a school to the left. Keep straight ahead "Kattegattleden" until Havsbadsvägen and Nybron. Turn right and walk over the bridge, then take the first right and follow the stairs down to the river.

Turn right again and go under the bridge and follow the gravel path. In a little over 300 m you can see Pyttebron (1) diagonally to the left. The path splits before the bridge, follow the path sloping up to the right. After about 50 meter you see a big "crane". Pass it and walk towards to the car road. Then turn left onto the pedestrian and bicycle path that runs along Danielslundsgatan.

Pyttebron:

Built in 1904 as a railroad bridge and was part of a joint, "Pyttebanan" between Ängelholm and Klippan. The name comes from the word "pytte" that means chicken in Skåne. The reason that the rail trail came to be called "Pyttebanan" was the carpenter Johan Wilhelm Hall let his hen scratching around at the railway embankments. This was not to everyone's satisfaction during that time! The bridge has been a big topic of conversation when the planned new car road here. And the last word is not yet said!



You pass a miniature golf course on your left side and reach Hembygdsparken after about 300 meter (2). Keep following the pedestrian and bike path along Danielslundsgatan about 300 meter. You pass among other things a popular adventure course, Upzone on your left side.

Hembygdsparken: In the 1700's this place was sandy desert. Today, the park has about 300 000 visitors per year. The park includes museums where machines from Grönvalls leather factory is available to watch, a restaurant, a playground, an open air theater and a small zoo.



There woodland on the left side enters buildings you turn left on gravel road. You are now turning back and heading towards the city center. Once you go along Rönne river that you have on your right. You pass the entrance to "Pytteskogen", a playground for children and deer enclosure which is part of Hembygdsparken.



The gravel road leads you to a green space, Tullakrok (3) where you can find public opportunities to grill.



Continue on the gravel road along the river, pass Pyttebron and Nybron right up to the big bridge, a distance of about 1200 meter.



Here you turn left up the stairs, then immediately right onto a cobblestone street. After about 50 meter you reach Tingshusstorget(4). You pass, Sofia Nilssons pottery on your right and "old" Courthouse in front of you. Cross the square and continue past the library and return to the main square.

A nature walk in Kronoskogen with close encounters of both sea, sand and the extraterrestrial presence. Documentation is everything from flat tarmac and gravel road to the small forest paths, partly marked trail.

Start/Finish: Main Square at, Espresso House

Distance: 10,2 km

Route description:

The start is the same as for hiking 1. The walk starts in the main square, go south, about 200 m until you reach the T-junction, here you turn left and follow the road towards Karl XV's bridge. You pass a small park on your right side, "Vita Räck" and soon after you reach a junction where you go right over the bridge.

Continue straight along Södravägen past Ängelholms hospital. Cross the car road at the roundabout and proceed further 100 m and on into the pedestrian and bike path. You pass under a railway bridge and after 100 m turn right, follow the sign "Lergöksrundan". Continue straight into the residential area. After 250 m turn left and continue to follow "Lergöksrundan".

After about 500 m you reach another "Lergöksrundan" sign pointing to the right, which you follow. You now enter a forest area. Continue following "Lergöksrundan" you will soon turn right and pass under a railway bridge, and in front of you there is Kronoskogen. At the wooden information board, turn left and follow the tarmac road south about 200 m before you turn the right onto the gravel road (picture below).



Take the first path to your left and follow the white trail to a paved walkway. Follow the walkway to the end and continue on the car road 30 m. Cross the road and go into the woods on the trail marked with a yellow clay cuckoo (1) which you follow for just over 800 m. You cross a small footbridge and walk through dense forest. The path leads you to an open space with the UFO Monument (2).

Gösta Carlsson also known as, "Pollenkungen", developed collecting pollen on a large scale and in 1953 founded the company AB Carnelle ten years later founded the subsidiary Allergon with the intent to produce raw materials for allergy medications. Gösta Carlsson also told us that he May 18, 1946 been visited by aliens. The meeting in the glade in Sibirien, where today there is a UFO monument should have given Gösta knowledge of how pollen extracted from pollen grain. A ring and a rod was found even when the visitors left. Gösta Carlsson has also contributed to the hockey club Rögle BK:s success in the 1960s and the team currently playing in the SHL (Swedish Hockey League). Gösta Carlsson was 85 years old and died in 2003.

From here you can choose many paths, look for the yellow clay cuckoo -mark and follow the path until you reach the car park, you pass among other things a wooden bridge. Follow the road down to the sea, turn right onto RED - marked trail. It runs parallel to the beach until "Råbocka camping". You can gladly walk on the beach and then take the suggested alternative route (3).

As you approach the camp through the red track trail will divide. Turn off from the red trail (which turns right and across a wooden footbridge) and go straight to the camping. You will soon reach a gate that leads you into the area itself. Follow the gravel road to your left through the campsite and to the entrance. (Have you gone to the beach, you will arrive here). Directly after the camping turn right and follow the pedestrian and bicycle path around 300 meter. You have the campsite on your right side. At the camp's end, you reach an information sign, proceed further about 200 m, past the holiday village, "Klitterbyn". Along the way there are several paths to the right into the woods. Turn right onto the trail by wooden sofa showing billboard blue, yellow, red and white.



Then follow the red mark to (4) on the map. It turns the red and the blue trail to the right. Now follow the orangemarket to the left, it is a part of "Skåneleden". It leads you through the forest and out to the railway museum, (5). From here, follow the walkway under the railway viaduct and continue over Järnvägsbron towards the city center. Follow Järnvägsgatan and soon to be in the main square.

This hike takes you along Rönne river through Haradal and Lunturtun to Skälderviken port. Varying surfaces, tarmac and gravel road into smaller paths.

Start/Finish: Main square at, Espresso House

Distance: 8,9 km

Route description:

The walk starts in the main square and begins with a walk through the center of Ängelholm along the pedestrian street

north. After 600 meters you will reach the city park on your right side and there you will find Jonas Högströms bronze statue (1). Pedestrian street ends and you reach Nybrogatan which you pass. Continue along Storgatan further 250 m. At the restaurant "Hummerhuset" turn left and walk down towards the river. Turn right and follow the path that takes you north along Rönne river.

After less than 50 m pass Pyttebrons (2) viaduct and continues further along the river. After 600 meters you will reach a green area, Tullakrok (3).



Tullakrok

Is known for its music festivals. It was earlier organised each year a music festival and the performers were often unknown or were about to have a breakthrough. Artists who have performed here include The Ark and The Cardigans. Today, this has been expanded green space and barbecue areas has been prepared and is a popular place for the community.

Continue on the walkway along the river until you come to a major road. Turn left and follow Danielslundsgatan. After 400 m you pass "Ängelholms Brukshundsklubb" with fitness area on your left side. Where the river passes now Rönneholm (4), the largest island in Rönne river.



Rönneholm- A Historically entertainment center and a murder scene. There is not wellknown that Rönneholm is the largest island in the Rönne river. Today it is overgrown and difficult to discover. It is known for two things, an entertainment center and a murder scene. Many years ago, people danced and enjoyed themselves on the island. One of Swedens's most powerful men in the middle of the 1300s, Bengt Algotsson tried to hide here to escape death. Unfortunately, he failed and was killed. Bengt Algotsson was the duke of Halland, Finland and the governor of Skåne.

Continue along Danielslundsgatan, further 800 m until you reach Lunturtun (5). Follow the pedestrian and bicycle path down to

your left towards the river, follow the sign "Klitterhus 1,5 km".

Luntertun

Luntertun has been a medieval Skånsk city. The Danish king Kristian II decided in 1516 that this city and parish would cease to exist and he founded instead of Ängelholm city a little further upstream. Today, there are remains from the parish church ruins left and the church bell is still preserved in Ängelholm church.



Soon reached a wooden bridge, "Vassbron" as you pass, now approaching the port that can be glimpsed in front of you. Follow the road along the paddock, turn left at the sign "Klitterhus 1 km". (6)



Pass under the railway viaduct and turn right. Then the first left towards the harbor and sea. You will soon reach up to Skälderviken marine.



Continue straight over the bridge and follow the walkway which curves to the left. After about 150 m you reach a parking lot on your left side of the road straight ahead leads to Klitterhus, whose roof you can glimpse (7).



Klitterhus

A traditional seaside hotel, its octagonal pavilion was built in the early 1900s. After a heavy storm in 1922 when the whole pavilion was to demolish the entire building was moved a bit up in the dunes and the straight wing was built, and some later built even one more pavilion. Since then, the hotel has retained its shape. Many people have performed here over the years including by artist Povel Ramel which debuted in the pavilion with his student orchestra. Concerts, dance competitions and discos were once frequent. You can now live and eat well.

Turn now to the left at the whitewashed stones and follow the grass path. Go along



the landscaped embankment that follows the river. The

path ends up with a paved pedestrian and bike path. Turn left and then immediately right and follow the gravel path that leads under the railway bridge. Turn right immediately



and follow the gravel road until the junction is reached. Follow the training loop. Walk in the direction of the lights on the left side of

you. After less than 1 km you reach a fitness area.

Turn right and follow the road 400 m. Turn left onto the gravel road and up to the Pyttebron (2, read more at hiking 1). Turn right before the bridge, walk along Rönne river.

After about 350 m you reach stairs leading up to the road. Cross the road and continue on the walkway more than 250 m. Turn left over Sockerbruksbron and continue towards the center. Walk along the cobbled road to Ängelholms church, turn left at the church and back to main square.

On the way you pass Gabriella Sandins sculpture, "Till José" (8) on your right hand side.
